Dear Arts, Crafts & Retail Sales Vendor:

Thank you for your interest in the **2019 Santa Rosa Wednesday Night Market**. The 2019 Santa Rosa Wednesday Night Market Season will run every Wednesday from **May 15 to August 28 from 5:00-8:30 pm**.

The Santa Rosa Wednesday Night Market provides vendors, as well as market-goers, a wonderful event bringing the community together to enjoy a variety of food, arts & crafts, fresh produce, non-profit agencies, entertainment and activities. The Market has drawn more than one million people to Downtown Santa Rosa over the past thirty years and will continue to attract thousands each night this season.

PLEASE READ through each page and initial at the bottom. The last page requires a signature. The application processes and deadlines are as follows:

- Enclosed you will find a **2019 Application Form and Rules and Regulations for Market Vendors**. We recommend submitting the application, a **\$25 non-refundable application fee** and the initialed Rules and Regulations as soon as possible to be considered for the first Market on May 15th. Applications will be considered as availability allows on a first come first served basis. Applications are accepted throughout the Market Season. Please allow up to 2 weeks for processing once the Market has begun.
- Vendor required permits, licenses and other applicable data is indicated on the application – these documents must be received by the Market Manager for all approved Vendors.
- Additionally, your first week's booth payment or full season's pre-payment is due on April 26th, 2019.
- **PLEASE NOTE** All Vendors will be required to pay their booth fees one week in advance of each Market night attending. Vendors who are delinquent on their payments **will not be allowed to set-up their booth**.
- **PLEASE NOTE** Any Vendor who is two (2) weeks or more delinquent in payments is considered failing in fulfilling the applicant's obligations and all future reserved Market booth spaces will be cancelled.
- **Credit Card payments** are accepted online. Once a booth space is approved, invoices will be sent by email and an online payment option will be available on the invoice. Credit Card payments will also be accepted at the Information Booth at the Market for future weeks.
- **Vendors must notify the Market Manager no later than 48 hours before the Market if they will not be attending at a given Market or they will be charged for the space. They may call or text (707) 524-2123 or email market@sonic.net 48 hours in advance of non-attendance.**
- Once your permits, licenses, other applicable data and payment have been received you will be notified by email with a Market driving map, general information and your assigned booth location.
- Each Vendor is responsible for all parking fees – no vehicles are allowed to park within the Market area (except for select Farmers).
- The Market participates in the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) for fresh farmed goods. See our Frequently Asked Questions website page for more information.
- **Electrical power is not provided to Market Vendors.** Please be prepared to supply your own power. (Silent generators must be used no louder than 80 decibels.)

Please include the following along with your completed application:

- \$25.00 non-refundable application fee. (Checks payable to: Wednesday Night Market.)
- Initialed Rules and Regulations and Signed Agreement.
- All required permits and/or documents as noted on application.
- If new to the Market, photographs of the items you propose to sell and a diagram or photo of your booth set-up (photos will not be returned).

*A Certificate of Insurance (\$1,000,000) naming as additionally insured the Thursday Night Market Association, Inc. and the City of Santa Rosa will be required if application is approved.

Please note – If the Early Bird Rate is chosen and not paid by April 26th, 2019 – Vendor rate will automatically revert to weekly rate as of 4/29/2019.

Payments may be made by check to **Wednesday Night Market** via mail to the Address indicated below, or online via credit card (invoices with online payment option will be sent via email once a booth space has been approved). Weekly payments may be made at the Information Booth at the Market for future weeks with cash, check, or credit card.

2019 ARTS, CRAFTS & RETAIL SALES VENDOR RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Arts, crafts and retail sales Vendors will be approved as the Santa Rosa Wednesday Night Market ("Market") deems appropriate.
2. Space is limited. Early application is recommended. Vendors who wish to be considered for vending on Opening Night of the Market must apply as soon as possible.
3. The Vendor Selection Committee places priority on providing a variety of high quality, wholesome arts, crafts, and unique activities at the Market. Out-of- county applicants are considered after local applicants.
4. A waiting list of persons or organizations that wish to participate in the Market will be kept in the Santa Rosa Wednesday Night Market office. Any space that becomes available will be reserved for the applicant on the top of the list. Applicants must show they are qualified in all respects in order to be placed on the waiting list.
5. Applicant understands that he/she will not be allocated space until all of the documentation is approved and fees are paid in advance.
6. In order to ensure a quality, handcrafted Market, the Santa Rosa Wednesday Night Market requests that the maker is the seller. Immediate family members or partners who actually participate in the making of your handmade item on a regular basis may sell in your booth. Collectives and co-ops are approved on a case-by-case basis.
7. "Handcrafted" imports will be considered at the discretion of the Vendor Selection Committee. Machine made (factory) imports will also be considered. The Committee will select arts, crafts and retail sales that best meet the overall goals of the Santa Rosa Wednesday Night Market.
8. The Market will assign a location to each Arts, Crafts and Retail Sales Vendor. Space sizes are approximately 10' x 10' or 6' x 4' designated within the Market footprint. Booth location is subject to change per the Market Manager.
9. All operations must be within the marked space for your booth. No activities are allowed on sidewalks, sidewalk peninsulas between parking bays, or within the fire lane area of the street, unless specifically designated by the Market Manager. **There are no A-frame sandwich board signs allowed outside of your designated area.**
10. Demonstrations of the art or craft process are encouraged in all spaces, as appropriate.
11. The Vendor Selection Committee will make its decision based on an application, a photographic presentation, and/or a personal showing of the product as described in the Arts, Crafts & Retail Sales Application.
12. Approved applicants are responsible for providing:
 - a. The name of the responsible person who will be in attendance at the Market.
 - b. A copy of State Board of Equalization Sellers Permit & SR Business Tax Certificate.
 - c. Tables, chairs, furnishings, backdrops or any equipment needed for their booth.
 - d. Proper disposal of in-booth trash.
 - e. Silent generator power, if needed for demonstration (80 decibels or below).
 - f. Signs indicating Vendor name and price.
 - g. Approval by the Market Manager of any changes in items sold prior to changes being made. Items sold must be those items described in the application and initially approved by the Vendor Selection Committee.
13. Vendors should be aware that the Santa Rosa Wednesday Night Market liability insurance does **NOT** cover sellers. Vendors are encouraged to obtain their own liability insurance, as stated in the Santa Rosa Wednesday Night Market Rules and Regulations.
14. All Vendors are required to operate customer lines parallel to Market traffic, and in such a manner as to avoid interference with access to other Market Vendors.
15. Participants may not harass downtown visitors. Activities which are conducted in such a manner as to interfere with the goals or purposes of the Santa Rosa Wednesday Night Market may result in immediate removal from the Market without a fee refund.
16. Handbills may not be posted without City or property owner approval.
17. All fees are non-refundable. There are no refunds for rained out Markets.
18. All Vendors will be required to pay their booth fees one week in advance of each Market night attending. Vendors who are delinquent on their payments **will not be allowed to set-up their booth.**
19. Any Vendor who is two (2) weeks or more delinquent in payments is considered failing to fulfill their contract obligations and all future reserved Market booth spaces will be cancelled.
20. **Credit Card payments** are accepted online. Once booth space is approved, invoices will be sent by email and an online payment option will be available on the invoice. Credit Card payments will also be accepted at the Information Booth at the Market for future weeks.
21. **Vendors must notify the Market Manager no later than 48 hours before the Market if they will not be attending at a given Market or they will be charged for the space. They may call or text (707) 524-2123 or email market@sonic.net 48 hours in advance of non attendance.**
22. **Every Vendor must notify the Market Manager no later than 48 hours before the Market if he/she will not be attending at a given Market. You WILL be charged for the space if you do not call, 707-524-2123/text or contact by email Market@sonic.net 48-hours in advance of non-attendance.**
23. Vendors are responsible for paying any and all parking fees associated with parking. The Wednesday Night Market is not responsible for paying any parking fees or fines Vendors incur.
24. Vendor Rules and Regulations are subject to change and may be sent via email prior to the beginning of the 2019 Market Season. By signing below Vendor agrees to read and abide by all Rules and Regulations above and those sent at a later time by the Market Manager. Vendor also agrees each individual representing the Vendor at the Market will be made aware of and abide by the Rules and Regulations.

AGREEMENT

The undersigned agrees that he/she has read and understood the Rules and Regulations of the Thursday Night Market Association, Inc. dba the Santa Rosa Wednesday Night Market and will be able to comply with all of the Rules and Regulations described. The undersigned understands non-compliance may, at the discretion of the Market, result in removal of the activity from the boundaries of the Market. The undersigned further certifies that he/she is the responsible person referred to in the Rules and Regulations and that he/she is authorized to 1) execute this application on behalf of the group, and 2) accept legal processes on behalf of the group.

Applicant agrees to defend, hold harmless, and indemnify the City of Santa Rosa, its officers, directors, employees and volunteers, and the Santa Rosa Wednesday Night Market, its officers, directors, employees and volunteers from and against any and all claims for damages and any or all loss, provided such claim, liability or loss arises in whole or in part by any act or omission of applicant or that of any employee or agent of applicant, and so applicant agrees, irrespective of whether such claim, damages or loss also arose from or were caused by a negligent omission on the part of the City of Santa Rosa, the Santa Rosa Wednesday Night Market or any of its officers, directors, employees or volunteers. Applicant has read the Santa Rosa Wednesday Night Market's Rules and Regulations, the entire Vendor Application, is familiar with the Hours of Market Operation, all applicable Regulatory Agencies, Fees for the Market Season, and the Section herein regarding applicant's specific area of participation, and applicant agrees to conform to the regulations contained therein. All operations must be within the allocated space. No activities are allowed on sidewalks, sidewalk peninsulas between parking bays, or within the fire lane area of the street.
